## **TRAINING DETAILS**

Day 1 & 4: Tactical Clothing & gear (handcuffs & baton)

Day 2 & 3: Business Casual

Participants require; handcuffs, pouch, keys, belt for your pouch, baton, and scabbard for your baton.

Participants should have foundational knowledge of the criminal code and provincial statute authorities for powers of arrest and use of force as it pertains to security guards and private investigators. The defensive tactics and handcuff training can be physically demanding with repetitive training drills and exercises. Participants should be in reasonably good physical condition to meet the demands and standards required for this course.

Participants must pass both a written exam and physical skills evaluation in order to successfully complete the course.

Participants are encouraged to arrive approximately 15 minutes early.
